

## THE WALTER ROSE NEW DEVIZES PIE COMPETITION

### Terms & Conditions:

1. The Walter Rose New Devizes Pie Competition ['the Competition'] is open to all competitors who have registered to enter and bought an entry ticket via the Devizes Food & Drink website: [www.devizesfoodanddrinkfestival.info](http://www.devizesfoodanddrinkfestival.info) or in person from Devizes Books.
2. 'We', 'Us', 'Ourselves' or similar words mean Devizes Food & Drink Festival ['DFDF'].
3. The event sponsor is Walter Rose & Sons Ltd ['the Sponsor']
4. Each pie to be entered will require that a separate entry be registered.
5. There are two categories: Meat and Vegetarian.
6. Recipes for each category must be new and original and not have been published, made or sold previously.
7. Each pie must be accompanied by a list of ingredients including any known allergens.
8. Each pie must be suitable to be served cold and encased in pastry [the composition of which is the decision of the entrant].
9. DFDF Committee members, the event Sponsor, their employees and associates may not enter the competition.
10. Pies must be delivered to the Corn Exchange, Market Place, Devizes SN10 1HS between 09.30am and 10.00am on Saturday 25 September 2021.
11. Judging will commence at 11am on Saturday 25 September 2021.
12. The winners will be chosen based on the judges' decision, which will be final. No correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
13. The judges reserve the right not to award a winner if they deem the pies to be unsuitable.
14. The winner of each category will receive a £100 voucher from the Sponsor, redeemable at the Sponsor's shop, 21-22 Sidmouth Street, Devizes SN10 1LD, valid for any products sold in the shop. No cash alternative will be offered.
15. DFDF retain the right to substitute the prize with another prize of similar value in the event the original prizes offered are not available.
16. DFDF accept no responsibility for any costs associated with entry to the Competition.
17. The winners will be announced at the event at 12.00 noon unless the judges decide that they need more time to agree on the winning pies.
18. The winners may be required to participate in promotional activity related to the Competition and shall participate in such activity upon our reasonable request.
19. The winners agree to allow the Sponsor to use the winning recipes to create and sell the pie should the Sponsor so wish, for a period of three months from the competition judging date [25 September 2021].
